

City Manager Work Plan Items:

- Review/change City Charter:

It is time to review the city charter. We will start discussions and have workshops to go over possible changes.

- Storm Water Rate Study:

The Stormwater Utility Rate Study will be presented to council, on June 2.

- RFPs:

Modernize Audio/Visual System – going out for RFP

- Hoffner Ave Traffic Improvements Grant:

The city has the fully executed State Funded Grant Agreement (SFGA agreement) between the city and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). The city has no match money for this project. The new project scope has been submitted.

- Annexation:

The city is looking into involuntary annexation as there is no movement by the county.

- Stormwater Appropriation – THUD:

We have submitted a new appropriations request for FY 2027 – flood mitigation, through Rep. Darren Soto for \$3.6M.

- Judge/Daetwyler Dr. Transportation Grant:

The design has started and we are addressing issues for FY 25/26.

- Purchasing Policy

We have received our new updated purchasing policy back from our attorney. We are good with the changes and will be bringing this to council for approval.

- Hurricane Ian:

FEMA is still investigating and deciding on whether to accept the updated documentation that was submitted by us. We continue to wait...
