7	FOR THE BOATS, VESSELS, AND WATERCRAFT IN THE IDLE SPEED, NO WAKE ZONE; PROVIDING
8	FOR EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR
9	SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11	WHEREAS, Hurricane Ian has caused extensive damage to the docks and boats, vessels, and watercraft
12	on the Conway Chain of Lakes; and
13	WHEREAS, there is a large amount of submerged or sunken debris such as docks and boats in the
14	Conway Chain of Lakes are considered hazards; and
15	WHEREAS, high boats, vessels, watercraft, and persons being towed by boats may not be able to see the
16	hazards throughout the Conway Chain of Lakes; and
17	WHEREAS, The Governor of the State of Florida issued a State of Emergency, Executive Order Number
18	22-219; and
19	WHEREAS, Section 4.C. of Executive Order Number 22-219 authorizes the political subdivision has the
20	power and authority to waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the political subdivision by
21	law pertaining to the performance of public work and taking whatever prudent action is necessary to ensure the
22	health, safety, and welfare of the community; and
23	WHEREAS, The City of Belle Isle is authorized under F.S. 252.38 to adopt emergency ordinances to
24	ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community

1		WHEREAS, given the uniquely hazardous present conditions, the Belle Isle City Council finds and				
2	determines that, subject to limited exceptions, an idle speed, no wake zone, is created on the Conway Chain of					
3	Lakes a	s set forth herein by emergency ordinance is necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare				
4	of the o	citizens of Belle Isle.

6	NOW,	THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA:				
7	Sectior	1. Findings. The City Council of the City of Belle Isle, Florida makes the following findings:				
8	a.	The prudent and safe operation of boats, vessels, and watercraft is essential to protect the public				
9		health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Belle Isle.				
10	b.	An Idle Speed, No Wake Zone in the Conway Chain of Lakes is necessary to avoid hazards to persons and				
11		damage to property resulting from boats, vessels, and watercraft traveling at excessive speeds.				
12	C.	The City Council is empowered to perform public work and take whatever prudent action is necessary to				
13		ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community under Section 252.38(5)(a) of the Florida				
14		Statutes.				
15	d.	The City Council is empowered to regulate the speed and wake of boats, vessels, and watercraft under				
16		252.38(5)(a) of the Florida Statutes.				
17	e.	The Belle Isle Police Department is empowered to impose penalties under 252.50 for violations of the				
18		regulated the speed and wake of boats, vessels, and watercraft under 252.38(5)(a) of the Florida				
19		Statutes.				
20	Sectior	2. Definitions				
21	a.	"Person" means an individual, partnership, firm, corporation, or other entity.				
22	b.	"Idle Speed, No Wake Zone" means an area of a waterway, in this instance the Conway Chain of Lakes,				
23		in which a boat, vessel, or watercraft cannot proceed at a speed greater than that specified by the Idle				
24		Speed, No Wake Zone definition in State Rule Chapter 68D-24.002

c. "Idle Speed, No Wake Zone" indicates a boating restricted area, in this instance the Conway Chain of Lakes that has been established to protect the safety of the public. "Idle Speed, No Wake Zone" means that a boat, vessel, or watercraft cannot proceed at a speed greater than that speed which is necessary to maintain Steerageway (Florida Administrative Code, Chapter 68D-24.002)

## d. "Boat, Vessel, or Watercraft" means any vessel being propelled or powered by machinery, including but not limited to personal watercraft

e. "Wake" means all changes in the vertical height of the water surface caused by the passage of a boat, vessel, or watercraft, including but not limited to a vessel's bow wake, stern wake, and propeller wash. f. "Steerageway" means the minimum rate of motion required for the helm of the vessel to have effect. Section 3. Prohibition. It shall be unlawful for any Person in physical control of a boat, vessel, or watercraft in the Idle Speed, No Wake Zone to operate the vessel in violation of the Idle Speed, No wake Zone within 500 feet of any boat ramp, hoist, marine railway, shoreline, or other launching or landing facility available for use by the general boating public; within 300 feet of a confluence of water bodies presenting a blind corner, a bend in a narrow channel or fairway, or such other area if an intervening obstruction to visibility may obscure other vessels or other users of the waterway, and hazardous water levels or currents, or containing other navigational hazards.

17 Section 4. Exemptions. The restrictions created by this Ordinance shall not apply to a vessel of a federal, state, 18 county, or City of Belle isle agency while operated by an officer, employee, or agent thereof who is engaged in law enforcement or other necessary city or governmental activity. Further, the restrictions created by this Ordinance, shall not apply to vessels operated under emergency conditions during a legitimate emergency. Section 5. Enforcement. This ordinance shall be enforced by the City of Belle Isle Police Department officers and any other authorized law enforcement officer as provided by Section 252.50 of the Florida Statutes.

9	Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately on passage by the City Council by at least				least			
10	by a two-thirds vote of the governing body. Further, this Ordinance will be filed with the Florida Fish and							
11	Wildlife Commission upon passage.
