5	WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Belle Isle committed to ensuring
6	the safe and efficient transportation of residents and visitors; and
7	WHEREAS, the City Council commissioned a transportation study in 2019 to
8	analyze and provide recommendations for the SCPS transportation system in light of
9	its population growth; and
LO	WHEREAS, the City received a grant from the Metroplan Orlando to further
11	refine the transportation plan; and
12	WHEREAS, concept plans were developed by the Metroplan Orlando consultant
13	for various streets in the City of Belle Isle;
L 4	WHEREAS, the school board now seeks to have an Ad Hoc Transportation
15	Advisory Committee review the findings and recommendation from the study and
16	provide recommendations to the Council.
L7	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLE

20	Section 1. Purpose.
21	City Council does hereby create the Transportation Advisory Committee to
22	review the City Transportation Plan and conceptual designs completed in 2019

and make recommendations to the Council for the development and

implementation of the plans.

1 Section 2. Definitions. The term "committee" as used in this chapter shall mean the city of Belle 2 Isle Transportation Advisory Committee 3 4 Section 3. Organization of the transportation Advisory Committee. 5 The committee is made up of seven (7) citizen members appointed by the city council. Members are appointed by District. 6 Section 4. Qualifications and terms of appointed members. 7 Appointments to the committee are made by the city council after an 8 9 application or letter of interest is filed with the city clerk. Appointments are made by District. Appointed members: 10 A. Must be a resident from each of the city's districts; 11 B. May not be officers or employees of the city; and 12 C. Must be qualified voters of the city. 13 All members are expected to attend all meetings and be active participants 14 in committee deliberations in a public setting. All members are expected to 15 read all of the materials related to their meetings, most of which can be 16 17 very long and technical and should be willing to dedicate several hours of 18 research, preparation and time for each scheduled meeting. 19 Section 5. Term of appointed members. 20 21 Members of the TAC will serve a term until advising is completed on the 22 assigned transportation projects and issues, if no other tasks are assigned 23 by the Council. The Council may continue the Committee to monitor and

oversee the effectiveness and status of the transportation plan and

- 1 recommend to the city council such changes in the transportation plan as may 2 be required. Section 6. No compensation. 3 4 Appointed members shall not receive compensation for serving in this 5 capacity. Section 7. Election of officers. 6 7 At its first meeting of the TAC, the committee shall nominate a chairman, vice-chairman, and secretary. Nominations of, and elections for, all 8 9 Officers shall be by a majority vote of those present.
- 10 Section 8. Duties of Officers
- 11 A. Chairman:
  - 1. The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Committee.
- 2. The Chairman shall schedule all meetings, assist in assembling the agenda for all regular and special meetings of the committee, and notify all members of said schedule.
- 16 B. Vice Chairman
  - 1. In the absence of the Chairman, the Vice Chairman shall preside over and assume all duties and responsibilities of the Chairman in addressing the business of any regularly scheduled or special meeting.
  - 2. Assist the Chairman in scheduling and coordinating all regularly scheduled and special meetings of the Committee.
- 22 C. Secretary
- 23 1. The Secretary shall take minutes of meetings and shall sign same as revised and approved.

1 2. In the absence of the Chairman and the Vice Chairman, the Secretary shall 2 preside over and assume all duties and responsibilities of the Chairman in addressing the business of any regularly scheduled or special meeting. 3 4 Section 9. Removal/vacancies of citizen members. 5 Citizen members serve at the pleasure of city council and may be removed by a majority vote of the city council. A member who is absent from three 6 consecutive meetings without the permission of the presiding officer is 7 presumed to be in nonperformance of duty, and the city council may declare 8 9 the position vacant. All committee vacancies shall be filled by the council, 10 for the unexpired term, for the remainder of the term within 45 days after 11 the vacancy occurs 12 Section 10. Meetings and notice. The committee shall hold one or more meetings according to the schedule 13 established by staff and the consultant. The committee may also meet at 14 other times during the year at its discretion. Committee meetings shall be 15 open to the public and noticed as required under Florida law. A quorum shall 16 17 consist of at least four members of the Committee. 18 19 Section 11. Authority and duties of the Transportation Advisory Committee. 20 The Committee's authority shall be advisory only. The Committee shall have

the following duties:

A. Review of all transportation policy and safety matters concerning all

forms of transportation affecting the City such as conventional vehicles,

transit, alternative modes, commercial vehicles, and attendant amenities.

Τ	B. Serve as a sounding board for citizen traffic, pedestrian and safety
2	issues and making recommendations to the City Council or City Administration
3	for appropriate action.
4	C. Aid in the development of City Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
5	by soliciting citizen input on needed projects for submission to the
6	Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council.
7	D. Coordinate with outside agencies and other local governments to develop
8	plans for transportation initiatives adjacent to the City.
9
