

Belle Isle Transportation Advisory Committee

Not happy with traffic in and around the City? Have ideas for solving some of the traffic problems? Want to know who controls what roads? The Belle Isle City Council is looking for volunteer residents to serve on the Belle Isle Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC). The TAC will serve in an advisory capacity concerning transportation projects and issues related to and including arterial streets, intersections, bicycles, pedestrians, and traffic management systems.

The Task Force will work to review and provide input on Belle Isle's overall transportation system to address needs in the areas of safety, traffic congestion mitigation, safe routes to school, and advanced traffic management systems.

The TAC be made up of seven residents, one from each District. The Council may also appoint alternates for each District depending on the interest and number of applicants.

The TAC will also work with Orange County on transportation initiatives for county-owned roads such as Hoffner Avenue, Matchett Road, and Gondola Drive, and work with the City's Traffic Consultant for improvements to Judge Road, Daetwyler Drive, and Hoffner Avenue. Committee members will be expected to attend regular meetings, work sessions, assist with data gathering and attend scheduled public workshops. Members of the TAC will serve a term until advising is completed on the assigned transportation projects and issues, if no other tasks are assigned by the Council.

To be considered for the committee, please submit a letter of interest detailing your history with the community, as well as any special skills and/or experience that you might bring to the committee by December 8, 2022. You must be a Belle Isle resident and registered voter to qualify for this Committee.
