

1 **RESOLUTION 18-08**

2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA,**
3 **AUTHORIZING TRANSMISSION OF A PROPOSED NON-AD VALOREM STORMWATER**
4 **UTILITY ASSESSMENT ROLL TO THE ORANGE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER FOR**
5 **INCLUSION ON THE NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAXES AND NON-AD VALOREM**
6 **ASSESSMENTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.069, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING**
7 **AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

9 WHEREAS, the City has by Ordinance 05-14 established a storm water management system
10 benefit area, which area encompasses all real property located within the City boundaries as
11 those boundaries may exist from time to time; and

12 WHEREAS, the City Council has authorized the City Manager to develop and recommend a storm
13 water utility fee rate schedule for the assessment of fees, for the use of and discharge to the
14 City's storm water management system; and

15 WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted and the City Council approves a proposed storm
16 water utility rate schedule, assessing each developed property in the City of Belle Isle at the
17 rate of \$110.00 per year per ERU contained on the property; and

18 WHEREAS, the City Council has approved an ERU of 4,087 square feet of impervious surface; and

19 WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted and the City Council approves a proposed non-ad
20 valorem storm water assessment roll, assessing each developed property in the City of Belle
21 Isle; and

22 WHEREAS, the proposed non-ad valorem assessment may be included in the notice of proposed
23 property taxes provided the Orange County Property Appraiser pursuant to s. 200.069, F.S.
24 (otherwise known as the TRIM notice), and the City Council has determined that such notice is
25 desirable;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA:

2 The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to transmit to the Orange County Property
3 Appraiser, no later than July 1, 2018 the proposed non-ad valorem storm water utility
4 assessment roll setting forth a proposed non-ad valorem assessment fee of \$110.00 per year
5 per ERU for each developed property in the City of Belle Isle, which proposed assessment shall
6 be included on the Orange County Property Appraiser's notice of proposed property taxes and
7 non-ad valorem assessments pursuant to s. 200.069, F.S.

8 This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
