

Proclamation

Declaring September 2016 Florida Suicide Prevention Month

every 14 minutes an individual in the United States dies by suicide; every 43 seconds there is a Whereas, suicide attempt in the United States and suicide is the 8th leading cause of death in Florida and 10th in the United States; and **WHEREAS** clinical care, supports, and interventions for mental, physical, and substance use disorders can reduce the risks for suicidal thoughts and behaviors; and **WHEREAS** family and community support as well as skills in problem solving, conflict resolution, and nonviolent ways of handling disputes, may reduce the risks for suicidal thoughts and behaviors; and **WHEREAS** suicide is viewed as the most preventable form of death, and education can often help save a life; **WHEREAS** the majority of people in crisis who receive the help they need are often not suicidal again; and WHEREAS the Florida Department of Children and Families Office of Suicide Prevention and the Suicide Prevention Coordinating Council, work in partnership with Florida communities to increase public
