A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA, TO ADOPT STANDARDS TO SAFEGUARD AGAINST CYBERSECURITY THREATS; ADOPTING THE METHODS AND STANDARDS SET FORTH IN VERSION 1.1 OF THE FRAMEWORK FOR CYBERSECURITY ADOPTED BY THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF STANDARDS AND TECHNOLOGY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, Section 282.3185 (4) Florida Statutes provides that each local government shall adopt cybersecurity standards that safeguard its data, information technology, and information technology resources to ensure availability, confidentiality, and integrity; and

Whereas, Section 282.3185 (4) Florida Statute provides that each municipality with a population of less than 25,000 must adopt the cybersecurity standards required by this subsection by January 1, 2025; and

Whereas, the City must notify the Florida Digital Service of its compliance with this subsection as soon as possible; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the cybersecurity standards set forth in Version 1.1 of the
Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity, promulgated by the National Institute of
Standards and Technology, provide standards that are consistent with generally accepted best practices
for cybersecurity; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that Version 1.1 of the Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity, promulgated by the National Institute of Standards and Technology, might be amended from time to time and that the methods and procedures provided for herein should be amended to include such amendments; and

1	Whereas, the City Council intends to adopt the p	provisions of Version 1.1 of the Framework for

3	Technology, in order to establish a framework to manag	e cybersecurity risks as follows:

7	c. Develop and implement the appropriate act	ivities to identify the occurrence of a
8	cybersecurity event.	
9	d. Develop and implement the appropriate act	ivities to take action regarding a detected
10	cybersecurity event.	
11	e. Develop and implement the appropriate act	ivities to maintain resilience plans and restore
12	any capabilities or services that were impair	ed due to a cyber-security event.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY	COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA,
14	AS FOLLOWS:	
15	Section I. The foregoing findings are incorporated	herein by reference and made a part hereof.
16	Section II. The methods and standards that are set	forth in Version 1.1 of the Framework for
17	Improving Critical Infrastructure Cyberse	ecurity, as may be amended from time to time,
18	which is promulgated by the National In	stitute of Standards and Technology, are hereby
19	adopted by the City to establish a frame	work for cybersecurity for the City.
20	Section III. The City's Internet Technology Director	or designee shall establish cybersecurity
21	procedures intended to accomplish the	following goals:
22	a. Develop an organizational understa	nding of how to manage cybersecurity risk to
23	systems, assets, data, and capabiliti	25.

1		b. Develop and implement the appropriate safeguards to ensure delivery of services.
2		c. Develop and implement the appropriate activities to identify the occurrence of a
3		cybersecurity event.
4		d. Develop and implement the appropriate activities to take action regarding a
5		detected cybersecurity event.
6		e. Develop and implement the appropriate activities to maintain resilience plans and
7		restore any capabilities or services that were impaired due to a cyber-security event.
8	Section IV.	Version 1.1 of the Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity,
9		promulgated by the National Institute of Standards and Technology, as may be
10		amended from time to time, is adopted by reference as the policy to govern the City's
11		efforts to protect against cyber threats. All amendments to Version 1.1 or updated
12		Versions of said Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity shall be
13		automatically adopted by the City, and the City's cybersecurity policy shall be amended
14		accordingly.
15	Section V.	Upon the city complying with the requirements set forth in Section 282.3185 (4) Florida
16		Statutes, the Internet Technology Director or his designee shall notify the Florida Digital
17		Service as soon as possible.
18	Section VI.	If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or
19		unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect
20		of any other section or part of this Resolution.
21	Section VII.	This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
