

SEC 28-103. Registration of Septage Hauling

A. The City shall establish guidelines for the registration of septage hauling and it shall be unlawful for any person to carry on or engage in the business of cleaning of septic tanks, cesspools, grease traps, seepage pits, vault privies, chemical toilets and other receptacles of human sewage or to transport over the streets in the City of Belle Isle unless they are registered with the City of Belle Isle and hold a license issued by the State of Florida and by Orange County under Orange County code Section 37-739 for carrying on such business.

B. Application for registration and other required license and permits shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk. At a minimum, besides the required state and county permits and licenses, septic haulers must provide its business name, local business tax receipt number, contact person, address and telephone number.

C. The city keeps a list of businesses that are allowed to operate in the city. This list is to assist in providing residents with a variety of choices for a service or product. Any specific commercial product, process, or service by trade name, trademark, manufacturer, or otherwise, is not an endorsement or recommendation by the city or its employees. Further, the city does not endorse or recommend any commercial products, processes, or services. The city will not recommend one service over another to residents

D. In the event any registered septic hauling service is determined by the city manager or designee to have violated the city's requirements pertaining to septic hauling, that service shall be suspended and removed from the list of registered services with written notice mailed to the service and shall not be authorized to conduct business within the City of Belle Isle for a minimum of one year from the date of the suspension. Any service that has been suspended and removed from the list may make a request in writing to the city clerk for a hearing before city council to appeal the removal.

Certification Statement: This application is to be signed by the owner of the business, or officer of a corporation, after adequate completion of this form and review by the person signing below. "I have examined and am familiar with the information submitted in this application. I believe that the

information submitted is true, accurate and complete. I agree to accept and to abide by all applicable ordinances and regulations of the City of Belle Isle.

I understand that falsification of any information submitted shall be cause for termination of the Liquid Waste (Septage) Transport Permit. I acknowledge that this permit authorizes the transport of only those liquid wastes listed above in item 14 and I understand that no hazardous waste or industrial waste is to be transported or mixed with liquid waste hauled under this permit.

Any person willfully or negligently violating PERMIT conditions is subject to a fine of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense. Further, the CITY may issue Notice of Violation, conduct show cause hearings, revoke this PERMIT and initiate legal actions to enforce the Ordinance and PERMIT conditions. The CITY may invoice the PERMITTEE for costs incurred for any cleaning, repair, or replacement work caused by a violation or discharge, and in the event PERMITTEE fails to make payment of any such invoice, the CITY may suspend Liquid Waste (Septage) Transport Permit.

I understand that the permit is valid for one year or as specified by the permit itself and must be renewed on an annual basis to maintain a valid permit.”
