Subject: BING Grant

Background: Lake Conway Shores HOA applied for a BING Grant in the amount of \$8,750 to replace the pavilion at the lake lot that was destroyed by Hurricane Irma. Commissioner Gold allocated his \$7,500 in BING Funds to this project and Commissioner Sue Nielsen contributed \$500 of her BING Funds. Plans for the structure have been approved and are on file in the City Manager's Office.

Staff Recommendation: Approve the grant

Suggested Motion: I move to approve the BING Grant for Lake Conway Shores HOA for the pavilion for the requested grant amount of \$8,000.
