General Items:

I attended the Municipal Planners Open House on September 25, 2025, hosted by the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission. The session provided an overview of the Prince George's County Planning Department, led by Chairman Darryl Barnes and Director Lakisha Hull, and highlighted its core divisions: Community Planning, Countywide Planning, Development Review, and Management Services.

Key updates included:

- A shift to a cloud-based Development Application Review Tracking System (DARTS) to enhance service delivery.
- Ongoing placemaking and housing initiatives, including the Missing Middle Housing Study and Accessory Dwelling Unit legislation.
- Major planning efforts such as the Southern Maryland Rapid Transit and Westphalia Sector Plan Update.
