



Highlights for Code Enforcement June 2026



There were **8** bulk trash reminder notices issued to residents for heavy trash at the curb.

1. Code Enforcement removed **-10** signs from poles, **28** from right of ways: total signs Removed year –to- date is **213**
2. There were **23** abandoned vehicles in the residential area, **6** in the business area, **1** in the apartment area, and **1** vehicle was impounded. Year-to-date, we have had **85** abandoned vehicles and **3** vehicles have been impounded.
4. There were **9** grass violation notices issued
5. Code Enforcement received **3** graffiti complaints.

Other Code Enforcement Activities:
