3. Public Works fabricate benches for people waiting for the bus. Guys did a great job.

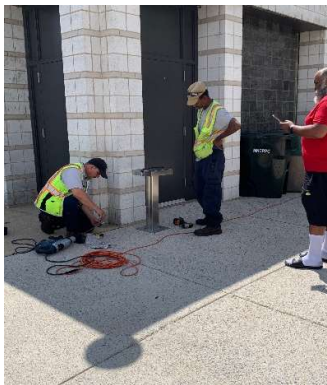


4. Part of Public Works building inspection includes changing smoke detector, fire extinguishers, etc.
