Staff recommends the passage of this contract and allows the Town Administrator to implement this project. The Town recommends the lowest and most responsive bidder.	
Item Summary:	
The Town of Bladensburg requested sealed bid proposals from consultants to provide on-call Lighting Project 57th Avenue for a reduced scope to place a portion of the originally proposed scope released in March 2024. This scope was amended because the full scope far exceeded the Town's budgeted funds.	
The Town received two responses:	
Lighting Maintenance Inc. - This price is based on installing 10 poles only. Poles SL9-SL13, and SL30-SL34. Pricing includes the following: - Electrical Permits - Prevailing Wages based on PG County Wage Determination dated 4/08/2024 - Installation of (10) pole foundations per drawing E2 detail - Furnish & Install (10) light poles & fixtures - Install PEPCO lateral electrical service - Install new Electrical Service equipment and housekeeping pad - Furnish & Install new conduit via directional drilling to include 5" HDPE at road crossings and junction boxes on either side - Furnish & Install XHHW conductors and terminate - 3rd Party Inspections - \$ 192,827.47
