

Public Works activities for October, 2024:

During the month of October, Public Works worked on the following activities:

1. Public Works did and amazing job on the repairs/painting of the facial board at the Town Hall.





2. Due to the season change, Public Works has started plant winter cabbage and kale around the Town Hall and Town welcome signs.
