



Highlights for Code Enforcement March 2026



There were **12** bulk trash reminder notices issued to residents for heavy trash at the curb.

1. Code Enforcement removed **-20** signs from poles, **22** from right of ways: total signs Removed year –to- date is **86**
2. There were **10** abandoned vehicles in the residential area, **1** in the business area, **2** in the apartment areas, and **no** vehicles were impounded. Year-to-date, we have had **15** abandoned vehicles and **no** vehicles have been impounded.
4. There were **no** grass violation notices issued
5. Code Enforcement received **1** graffiti complaint.
