| NCRnet  | Regional            | <b>Regional Funding:</b> Essential for interoperability and coordination.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Review and update governance to ensure cost-sharing transparency, revisit existing MOUs, and ensure a regional approach to the program.</li> <li>• Develop a plan to modernize the program to increase efficiency, decrease costs, and expand the program; Loudoun County taking the lead with the CIOs.</li> </ul>   |
| CAD2CAD   | Regional            | <b>Regional Funding:</b> Essential for interoperability and coordination.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Review and update governance, as appropriate.</li> <li>• Explore how to expand its use beyond fire.</li> <li>• Explore other system options to decrease costs and standardize where possible; will need to manage the contractual commitments and avoid disruptions if changes occur.</li> </ul>  |
| COG Regional Homeland Security and Public Safety Support                              | Regional            | <b>Regional Funding:</b> Essential for interoperability and coordination.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continued need for DHSPS to provide regional governance and coordination.</li> <li>• Revise DHSPS' scope to better integrate homeland security, public safety, and public health based on the needs of the region.</li> </ul>   |
| NCRCIG Program (Radio Cache) – Strategic Planning/Sustainment                         | SME Input           | <b>Additional SME Input Needed:</b> Do not fund as currently structured; Conduct NCR Interoperable Communications Planning Assessment and revisit long-term cache strategy in consultation with SMEs. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The region should discuss whether the business case for this project has changed - including options for right-sizing the cache and modernization of technologies.</li> <li>• The NCR Interoperable Communications Planning Assessment was approved as part of the UASI FY 2025 decisions (September).</li> </ul>   |
| Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF) Fire Liaison  | SME Discussion      | <b>Additional SME Input Needed:</b> Feedback from the Fire Chiefs is needed to make a final recommendation on this program.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ROI of the program is not clear at the Strategy Group level.</li> <li>• Loudoun County currently staffs the position.</li> <li>• Feedback from RESF 4 is requested - if they find considerable ROI with the program, potentially fund through local fire department budgets.</li> </ul>   |
| NCR Watch Desk Program  | End                 | Do not transition to local budgets post-UASI.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NCR Watch Desk staff is being reduced from two positions per shift to one.</li> <li>• DC committed to maintaining the Watch Desk function in the short term to sustain essential reporting, such as the morning report and Regional Incident Communication and Coordination System (RICCS).</li> <li>• Expand regional Steering Committee to determine essential products and options for distributing Watch Desk activities across local watch desks and/or the fusion centers.</li> </ul> |
| NCR IMT   | End                 | <b>Additional SME Input Needed:</b> Feedback from the Fire Chiefs and other affected SMEs required to define ROI.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The ROI on this program is unclear; the total amount spent on this program compared to how it used in the region seems disproportional.</li> <li>• This investment could be used more strategically; the program in its current state is not identified as a priority due to the ability to request other national teams if needed.</li> </ul>  |
| Mass Care Cache   | End                 | Do not transition to local budgets post-UASI.   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maintain September 2025 HSEC decision to end the project at the end of the FY 2024 UASI award.</li> </ul>   |
| NCR ESSENCE Disease Surveillance Network Core Capability Sustainment                  | Alternative Funding | <b>Alternative Funding Source:</b> Transition responsibility of the program to local and/or state Departments of Health.  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• State and/or local Health Officials/health departments must decide whether to continue to fund the ESSENCE program using their budgets or identify an alternative funding source.</li> </ul>  |
| RITIS Regional Data Sharing and Situational Awareness O&M & Tech Refresh              | Alternative Funding | <b>Alternative Funding Source:</b> Transition responsibility of the program to local and/or state Departments of Transportation.  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• State and/or local Departments of Transportation must decide whether to continue to fund the RITIS program using their budgets or determine an alternative funding source.</li> </ul>   |
| Regional CCTV Interoperable Video Sharing Program for Public-Safety Personnel (MVIEW) | Alternative Funding | <b>Alternative Funding Source:</b> State of Maryland/MCAC exploring/identifying alternative funding source.   |  |

| NCR Preparedness System   | Local               | <b>Local Funding:</b> Support for staff positions at each jurisdiction's discretion   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maintain September 2025 HSEC decision to reduce preparedness staff by half, except for jurisdictions with one staff member, through June 2026.</li> <li>• Jurisdictions will determine whether to maintain this local capability with individual funding.</li> </ul>  |
