SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 2023-04. Camping & RV Parking.

As instructed by the Board of Trustees at the November meeting, Ordinance 2023-04 has been revised to define "infrequent" as camping and overnight accommodation for ten (10) total days a calendar month and for no more than four (4) consecutive days in a calendar month.

The Ordinance has also been revised to authorize the Town Manager to promulgate a permit process to <u>extend</u> the time of use beyond infrequent use. The Town Manager is authorized to set reasonable conditions for all permits or for any specific permit deemed necessary to protect adjacent property, such as, but not limited to, location of the camping or RV, noise, and lighting restrictions.

We will work with the Town Manager to create the administrative permit program which, as instructed by the Board, will be a no-cost application.
