


Figure 4 Straight Arm Bar Takedown – 1 Officer







- Scott Bruce and William McNeil, remaining occupants in RVs on site issued tickets for August 29,2023 appearance. Tickets moved to 9/19/23 requested public defender.
- Public Defender Carol Miller representing, asked Judge Bush for 60 days for removal of people on site and cleaning help. February 12th ,2024 is the last day. Court should be February 13,2024.

• 12/12/23 Ernesto Martinez appeared for himself and his wife Ruth Portillo. Judge allowed him to have me inspect property for compliance. 12/18/23 at 1:30pm property was inspected, Ernesto complied, court was notified for dismissal.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

Code Enforcement continued:

4 Laurel Ct.

- 2 residents complain that several cars parked on the street, overflowing to Goethe Rd. Appears to be the result of 2 apartments in a garage at this location and 2-3 campers being utilized as living areas.
- 6/7/23 site visited with Jordan Holloway and Bill Baugher. Appears no permits were issued for this garage site. Building department needs to review. On site possible daycare ongoing, 2 RVs connected need to be disconnected. Re-visited on Tuesday 7/18/23 all's ok water disconnected from RV's, permits for garage were Beaufort County not Bluffton.

10 Taylor Court

• Codes identified this location to Jordan Holloway (Growth Management) with regards to the owner obtaining any permits for land clearing at this site. None were obtained, this will be a site visit to be scheduled for June. 6/7/23 site visited, now pending meeting with Jordan and owner. Carrying over to 2024.

75 Goethe Road

• Residents complained about this location's abundance of tires, vehicles not registered on location and needs to be cleaned-up. **This site is pending inspection** for NOV issuance with PD.

331 Buck Island

- 6/7/23 property was visited by Codes, Lt. Ferrelli, Jordan Holloway, and Bill Baugher.
- 6/14/23 notified via email 252 Simmonsville flooding due to Ruiz Concrete action of backfilling a pond.
- 6/21/23 meeting with Jordan, myself, and Bill Baugher to discuss all violations. Jordan working on letter draft to be sent to owner of 331 Buck Island to include vehicle removals, RV disconnection, no permits obtained for housing, Residential Zoned Area, no construction yard allowed.
- Matter was handled by town attorney and Mr. Ruiz attorney with an agreement reached for a January 1,2024 full completion of removal of all construction items, cars and RV's.

170 A Goethe Road

• 7/13/23 spoke to the owner Richard regarding his non-registered vehicles on his corner property, advising him that they need to be removed. Richard stated that he is in the process of registering them for his son and daughter. I advised Richard, I would allocate him 10 days to comply, and he agreed. Richard stated he did not want any problems with the town. Richard was very cordial at the time of discussion. Been checking daily for compliance.
