Project Narrative for 106 Bridge Street Conceptual Application

The property owner, Jeffrey Zehel, wishes to construct a new residence and carriage house on a vacant lot. The property is located in the Neighborhood General Zoning District. The proposed building type is Medium House.

The buildings are vernacular in massing, materials and detailing speaking the architectural language of the contextual fabric of the surrounding neighborhood. The roof ridge of the carriage house is similar in height as the main residence roof line adhering to the UDO intentions that the carriage house be secondary in visual focus.

There is a significant live oak on the property. Measures have been taken to protect the tree such as locating the main house as far right as allowed, using a hipped roof, using one-story height and using a slight H shape layout.
