<u>Advertising:</u> Of the requested funds, 100% is anticipated to be spent on marketing the event. Where advertising will take place is not identified in the application.

Festival/Event: The event will be held on Sunday, November 3, 2024.

<u>Bluffton Event</u>: This year's event will again have rides of differing lengths including 2, 10, 30 and 62 miles with each starting at the Boys & Girls Club of Bluffton location. A 20 mile ride is also being added for 2024. The various routes will include rides through Palmetto Bluff, Sun City and Hampton Lake.

Tourism Draw %: In 2023, riders were from the Atlanta, Greenville, and Charleston markets.

<u>Benefit to Tourism</u>: With an 8 a.m. start time, most out-of-towners make a weekend visit to Bluffton and stay in local hotels, eat at local restaurants and patron local shops and businesses.

<u>Self-Sufficiency % (Financial Need)</u>: Amount requested is almost 79% of the total budget with the entire request being for marketing and advertising expenses. Sponsorships, donations and participation fees are expected to provide the remaining revenue. The 2023 event netted a profit of \$77,850 for the Boys & Girls Club; the 2024 event is anticipating a net fundraising effort of \$90,000.
