<u>Tourist Facilities:</u> The Sarah Riley Hooks Cottage Restoration Project was identified as a priority action item within the Town of Bluffton's FY2024-2025 Strategic Plan. Construction is ready to begin in June 2026 with an estimated completion in April 2026. The building was purchased in 2029 with the intent to rehabilitate the historic contributing structure to provide usable public space to promote the arts community. Included as part of the project is interpretive signage telling the unique story of the history, culture and environmental significance of the property.

<u>Tourism Draw %</u>: Because the project is not yet complete, a tourism percentage has not yet been tracked.

<u>Benefit to Tourism</u>: Once complete, the cottage and site will be added to the tours of the Historic District that are provided through the Squire Pope Welcome Center. The planned art gallery space will display local and regional work, attracting tourists to the area and enhancing their experience when visiting Bluffton. This will support an increase in retail, dining and lodging.

<u>Self-Sufficiency % (Financial Need)</u>: The request is 30% of the total construction budget of \$857,680. The remainer will be covered by Town of Bluffton funds.
