Key Efforts in July:

Operations and Marketing

- Al Advancements at TCL: Delivered the third presentation on Al, focusing on cutting-edge applications across various sectors.
- Al Speaking Requests: One of our strategic initiatives is to be recognized as the "thought leader of artificial intelligence in the low country". We held 4 Al Speaking events this month. TCL Colleton,
 ToB Debbie's team, National Association of Information Officers about the technology and are scheduled to speak to Hilton Head/Bluffton Chamber of Commerce staff, The Sea Pines CountryClub, the Beaufort Digital Corridor and a group at Hampton Lake
