**Project Scope** 

This project comprises the design and construction of sidewalks, pathways, and lighting along Buck Island and Simmonsville Roads from New Mustang South to May River Road. Approximately 10,000 linear feet of sidewalk has already been constructed within this neighborhood with an additional 6,000 linear feet of 5' wide sidewalk needed to complete the overall project. The primary focus of the new sidewalks and lighting is to create greater pedestrian connectivity and improve citizen safety. The remaining sidewalk work includes following: Phase 5 - Buck Island Road from Kitty Road northward to 301 Buck Island Road to connect to existing sidewalks. Phase 6 from Grayco northward to past Windy Lakes.
