Sec. 3.17 CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS – HIGHWAY CORRIDOR OVERLAY (HCO)

Purpose: To require that the application for a Certificate of Appropriateness – HCO be consistent with approved plans and agreements (including the addition of the Final Development Plan), and to remove the reference to "PUD" (as the HCO applies to areas not zoned Planned Unit Development).
