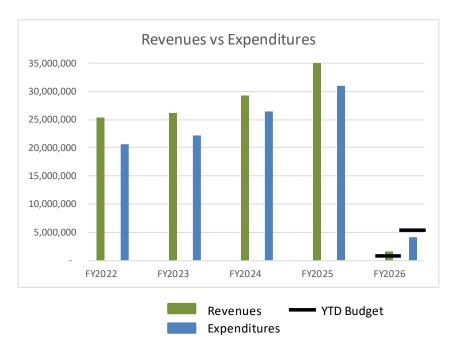

General Fund Financial Overview:

The chart below shows the revenue collections and expenditures trend for the last four full years and FY2026 year-to-date (YTD) through August 2025. Revenues have been higher than expenditures for the last four full years.



FY2026 YTD through August shows General Fund total revenues above the total budgeted amount with Building Safety Permits showing the largest impact, followed by Business Licenses. Software contracts were paid earlier in FY2026 compared to FY2025 for the Communications, Executive, Finance & Administration, and Human Resources departments. Municipal Court pays the public defender monthly in FY2026 rather than a lump sum, mid-year payment in prior years. Public Services purchased a budgeted cargo van early this fiscal year. Total expenditures for August are below the total budget.

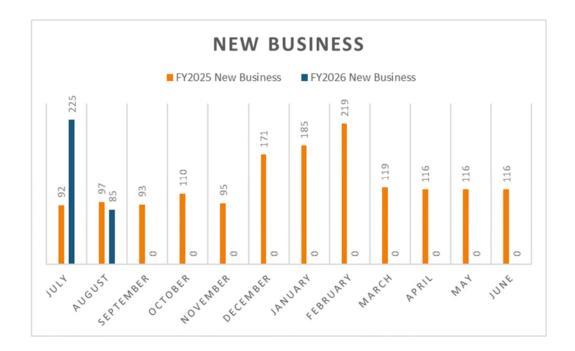

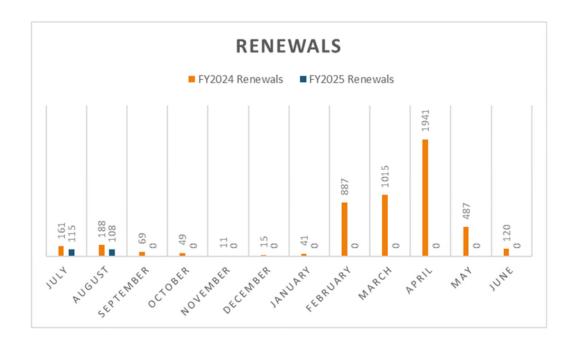

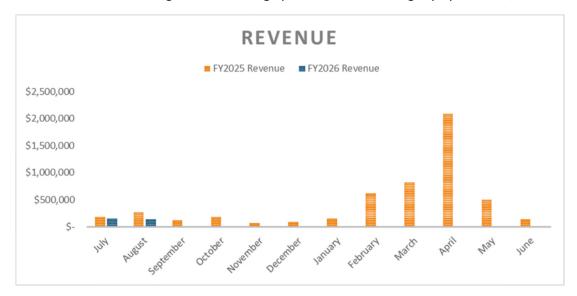
Business License Statistics:

Business License applications for FY2026 through August total 533 (310 new business and 223 renewals) compared to FY2025's total of 538 (189 new business and 349 renewals).





Business license renewals reflect a decrease of 43% or 80 and revenue collections decreased 62% or \$127,196 for the month of August when compared to last year as more businesses renewed timelier this year. Business license revenue generated through permits decreased slightly by 2% or \$1,482.



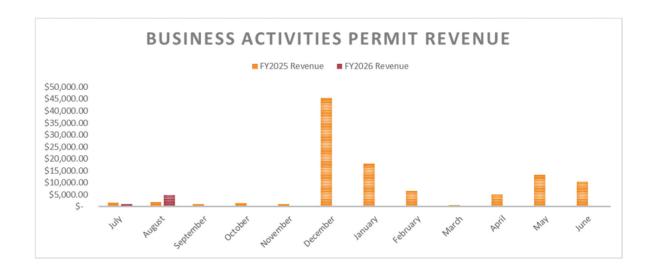
The amended ordinance that went into effect January 1st, 2019 included additional incentives for new businesses and businesses with multiple locations within the Town. For the 2025 business license renewals, there were five hundred, nineteen (519) renewals eligible for an incentive.
