REQUEST: Staff requests that Town Council to authorize the Town Manager to execute a Contract (Attachment 2) with Infrastructure Consulting & Engineering to provide design and construction administration services for Phase 2 of the Pathway Pedestrian Safety Improvements Project for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) in the amount of \$151,553.00 In addition, Staff requests a 15% contingency allowance of \$22,732.95 to cover any unforeseen changes that may arise during the term of the contract for a total fiscal impact of \$174,285.95.

The total contract amount is within the approved budget limit established in the Fiscal Year 2024 Consolidated Budget and illustrated on the attached Project Data Sheet (Attachment 3).

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The contract will include design, permitting, easements, construction documents and construction administration services for Phase 2 of Pedestrian Pathway Safety Improvements for compliance with the ADA within the historic district neighborhood. The project consists of approximately 33 ramp, detectable warning systems and pavement marking area improvements.

Staff solicited technical proposals per Town procurement procedures and received four responses to the Request for Qualifications (RFQu) posting. A formal review and selection team was formed and determined Infrastructure Consulting & Engineering to have the best qualifications, experience and perceived quality of services.
