

**CITY OF BOARDMAN  
ORDINANCE NO. 15-2026**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOARDMAN MUNICIPAL CODE TO  
AMEND TITLE 10 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Boardman ("City") has authority granted by the Boardman Charter of 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has an adopted Municipal Code which regulates traffic, parking, parades and funeral processions, abandoned vehicles, vehicle impoundment, and truck routes as part of Title 10 vehicles and traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has been working to better organize the Municipal Code that includes reordering chapters and titles, amending and adding provisions that are clearer and objective, and updating the Municipal Code to be more consistent with state law and current practice; and

**WHEREAS**, the Boardman City Council was informed of this potential change at a previous City Council meeting and were in support.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF BOARDMAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1 Affected and Attached Documents.** After full consideration of the matter, the City Council of the City of Boardman adopts changes to:

- **Title 10 Vehicles and Traffic** which is renamed to **Vehicles, Traffic, Parking, and Public Safety** and is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- All previous versions of **Title 10 Vehicles and Traffic** are hereby repealed and replaced.

**Section 2 Repealed Documents.** The following Resolutions that address parking and truck routes are repealed based on this action:

- Resolution 7-1986 addressing parking along Main Street.
- The portion of Resolution 6-1997 pertaining to parking on Main Street.
- Resolution 9-2001 pertaining to truck routes.
- Resolution 22-2009 pertaining to truck routes.
- The portion of Resolution 23-2009 pertaining to parking along truck routes.

**Section 3 Scrivener's Corrections.** The City Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to take all administrative actions necessary to correct any typographical errors, scrivener's errors, or formatting errors and to take all administrative actions necessary to codify these amendments within the Boardman Municipal Code.

**Section 4 Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after adoption, or October 1, 2026
