

**CITY OF BOARDMAN  
ORDINANCE 10-2026**

**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A PORTION OF SW MOUNT HOOD AVENUE TO SW  
MESQUITE STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF BOARDMAN**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Boardman operates the public rights-of-way within the City of Boardman; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that certain street names should be changed to improve clarity and address identification within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, to remove potential confusion about the terminus of SW Mount Hood Avenue for addressing purposes, it is proposed to rename the portion of SW Mount Hood Avenue, specifically the segment running north to south at its eastern terminus, to SW Mesquite Street, to be consistent with Phase 2 of the Chaparral Subdivision; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed change would remove potential addressing conflicts.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that the eastern terminus of SW Mount Hood Avenue, consisting of the segment running north to south, shall be renamed SW Mesquite Street.
