Water Department

- Replaced 10 inch meter at PGE valve.
 - Tie in on NE front and 4th street
 - Tie in on NE 3rd Street.
 - Continue troubleshooting and replacing inoperable meters throughout city.
 - Had training for new meters from Furgeson.
 - Install new meter vault at NE First and NE Boardman.
 - Army Corpse of Engineers inspection of City water system with no issues.

Wastewater / Collections

- Continue lift station washdowns.
 - Prepping for new manhole configuration for extension of NE Boardman to Olsen.
 - Automation system for chlorine system at lagoon.
 - Preparing for new head works at lagoon.
 - Continue irrigation from wastewater lagoons.
 - Continue receiving waste water to lagoon from AWS by truck.
 - Continue with collections survey throughout City mapping pipe size and material.

Streets, Parks & Facilities

- Continue work on street lamps and irrigation for North Main Street and NE Front.
 - Vacuum testing on man holes on streets at Chapparal.
 - Replaced regular lights with LED at waste water facilities.
 - Running irrigation at city parks and mowing, (we have over 20 acres of grass to mow weekly).
 - New mower was delivered and is being used with older mower to keep up.
 - Continue NE Front Street improvements.
 - Continue NE Boardman Ave, NE 3rd Street, and NE 4th Street connections.
 - Brush hogging of City Properties.
 - Opened splash pad for Summer.
