Overview

During May 2026, the Boardman Police Department continued to provide consistent law enforcement services with a strong emphasis on public safety, proactive patrol, and community engagement. Officers remained active throughout the reporting period balancing calls for service, proactive enforcement, and continued visibility within the community.

Department activity levels remained steady with continued focus on traffic enforcement, criminal deterrence, and neighborhood patrols.

Calls for Service and Patrol Activity

Total Incidents: 445

- Calls for Service: 229
- Officer-Initiated Incidents: 216

Officers maintained proactive patrol efforts while continuing to respond effectively to citizen-generated calls for service.

Proactive Enforcement Activity

- Traffic Stops: 144
- Vehicle / Pedestrian Checks: 48
- Bus / Building Checks: 22
- Other Officer-Initiated Incidents: 72

These activities reflect the department's continued efforts to deter criminal activity, improve traffic safety, and maintain a visible law enforcement presence throughout the community.
