

Water Department

- Repaired leak on Collector 3 main line.
- Repaired water main break near Macario's.
- Repaired water leak on Columbia Avenue.
- Repaired two water leaks at City Hall.
- Installed 25 radio reads and 5 new water meters across the city.
- GIS mapping of the new water system at Yates and Moli.
- Shut down and drained the cells at the old water building.
- Conducted training on the new pump station.

Wastewater Department

- Primed and removed mop heads at Lift Station 6.
- Started irrigation to the lagoons.
- Removed all materials from the east bay of the lagoon building.
- Shut down the old water building and removed the remaining items.

Parks and Irrigation

- Started irrigation systems for all city parks.
- Cleaned city park bathrooms and splash pad areas.
- Assisted Riverside High School (RHS) with irrigation setup.

Street Maintenance

- Completed repairs on the street sweeper; resumed full street sweeping.
- Covered potholes on various city roads.
- Removed snowplows from fleet equipment as winter has ended.
- Conducted repairs on the vac truck.
- Installed a mailbox at Mt. Hood, Faler, and Columbia Avenue intersections.
- Continued sidewalk cleaning efforts (ongoing).
- Flagging training completed for all Public Works employees.

Vehicle services and repairs

- Vacuum Truck Repairs
 - Our vac truck underwent necessary repairs to ensure it remains operational for city operations.
- Street Sweeper Repair
 - The street sweeper was out of service for a short period due to mechanical issues. Repairs were completed, and they are now back in operation.
- New Service Box Installation
 - We are currently assembling a new service box to be mounted on the maintenance crew's pickup truck. This upgrade will allow for better organization of tools and materials, improving efficiency for field work.
