    - All Institutional uses in B-4 District changed from Permitted by right to Conditional use, requires approval by the Planning Commission.
  - 4. Discuss amending §2.07.03 Parking and storage of certain vehicles.
    - Change from having to be in enclosed structure to being situated in the rear yard as not to be a visible nuisance from the public roadway or adjoining property.
