# Boaz Senior Center

## September 2022 Report

During the month of September:

We served 1,687 meals. Of these 1,012 were homebound delivered and 675 were served here at the center,

We logged 584 trips on 2 buses and 3 vans. We had a total of 1,632 vehicle miles and total passenger miles 1,563. This includes medical, shopping, and delivering food and our route to pick up and bring to center. We have averaged 40-45 people a day.
