BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The current ordinance does not contain an updated, clear, and concise right-of-way management process and policy.

Over the past few years and especially this past year, there has been an increase of requests to install various utility infrastructure in our rights-of-way and the current provisions of Chapter 17, “Streets and Sidewalks,” Article II, “Excavations” are not sufficient to maintain adequate city oversight of such work, which in turns causes damage to vital city infrastructure and disruptions to the use of city rights-of-way by the City.

This update of our ordinance will help set the expectations for utility contractors, to give our utilities a wide berth, to minimize damage and restore the area disturbed to its original condition.
