BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In the interest of cooperation, the City of Breckenridge has several interlocal agreements with Stephens County. The City and County have been discussing updates to several of them including the shared use of Stephen's County Law Enforcement Center building. The City and County held a joint meeting to discuss the details of the agreements and several updates.

The biggest update to the LEC building include:

- 1. The City will pay for cost associated with any increase in bandwidth for use of the internet.
- 2. The County will allow two (2) beds to be made available for use by BPD to house class C Misdemeanors (previous agreement allowed for eight (8) beds).
- 3. The City will pay \$50 dollars per day for each prisoner housed over the two-bed limit.
- 4. The City will be responsible for all costs associated with the out-of-county housing of city prisoners including transportation costs, medical costs, costs of guards, costs of housing charged by neighboring counties.
