BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In the interest of continued cooperation between the City of Breckenridge and Stephens County, the City maintains several interlocal agreements with the County. One such agreement provides for Animal Control services within the unincorporated areas of Stephens County.

The current Animal Control Interlocal Agreement is set to expire on September 30, 2026.

The City and County have discussed establishing a common expiration date for all interlocal agreements to streamline the renewal process and provide greater administrative convenience for both entities. To accomplish this, the proposed agreement will have an initial 15-month term, extending through December 31, 2027.

Following this initial term, subsequent agreements would be established on 12-month terms, allowing the City and County to maintain a consistent annual renewal schedule for their interlocal agreements.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

\$37,500.00 (\$30,000 annual) payable in 15 monthly payments of \$2500.00/month.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Consider approval of renewing Animal Interlocal with Stephens County and authorize the City Manager to execute the documents.
