BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In the interest of continued cooperation between the City of Breckenridge and Stephens County, the City maintains several interlocal agreements with the County. This agreement is for the shared use of Stephen's County Law Enforcement Center building.

The current Law Enforcement Center Agreement is set to expire on September 30, 2026.

The City and County have discussed establishing a common expiration date for all interlocal agreements to streamline the renewal process and provide greater administrative convenience for both entities. To accomplish this, the proposed agreement will have an initial 15-month term, extending through December 31, 2027.

Following this initial term, subsequent agreements would be established on 12-month terms, allowing the City and County to maintain a consistent annual renewal schedule for their interlocal agreements.

This update to the interlocal agreement does not alter what was previously approved and will remain in effect for the fifteen-month term.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Consider approval of the updated LEC Building Interlocal Agreement with Stephens County and authorize the City Manager to execute the documents.
