

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE, TEXAS DECLARING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Breckenridge (the “City”) is a Home Rule Municipality acting under its Charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code;

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City (the “City Commission”) finds that certain equipment described as Hypress SCBA 3000 psi Air Compressor (mid-1990 model) (the “Equipment”) is not needed by the City and is hereby declared to be surplus property;

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the City of Albany is in need of such Equipment and has agreed to provide the City with air bottles in exchange for the Equipment, which would be useful to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it would serve a public purpose of the City for the Equipment to be exchanged with the City of Albany.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE, TEXAS THAT:

1. The foregoing recitals are adopted as facts and are incorporated fully herein.
2. The City Commission hereby declares the Equipment, as defined herein, as surplus property that is not needed by the City of Breckenridge.
3. The City Commission authorizes the exchange of the Equipment with the City of Albany as described herein.
4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions and execute any necessary paperwork to exchange the Equipment with the City of Albany.
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Commission.
