AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND APPROPRIATED RESOURCES FOR THE BUDGET YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2022.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE, TEXAS:

- Section 9. That the sum of \$200,000 is hereby appropriated out of the Street Maintenance Sales Tax Fund.
- Section 10. That the sum of \$2,000 is hereby appropriated out of the Breckenridge Park Fund.
