AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF POLICE PORTABLE RADIOS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES TO VASU COMMUNICATIONS IN EXCHANGE FOR CREDIT TO PURCHASE NEEDED SPEAKER MICROPHONES AND BATTERIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article II of its Charter, the City of Brecksville may exercise its power of local self-government through the enactments of the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

The Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to trade in SECTION 1. equipment no longer needed for municipal purposes to Vasu Communications in exchange for credit in the amount of eight hundred and ten dollars (\$810.00) for the purchase of needed speaker microphones and batteries, as listed on the Police Asset Transfer Request and Vasu Communications Quotation attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as if by reference.

The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency relates to the need to transfer the outdated equipment and use the credit for the purchase of needed supplies, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
