

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) USED 2019 PETERBILT TRACTOR TRAILER TRUCK FOR USE BY THE BRECKSVILLE SERVICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OHIOBUYS/ODOT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Brecksville deems it cost effective to purchase certain equipment through the State of Ohio, Administrative Services Purchasing, OhioBuys/ODOT Program; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2024 the City of Brecksville Service Garage and equipment in said garage were damaged by fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized on behalf of the City of Brecksville to enter into a contract with the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing, OhioBuys/ODOT Program through its authorized vendor, Hissong Group, Inc./Kenworth of Richfield, such contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law, for the purchase of the following equipment for use by the Service Department:

SECTION 2. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer’s certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is it is necessary for the Service Department’s daily operations, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
