

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 145.05(b) OF
THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO DESIGNATE
ONE TOUR OF DUTY AS A FLOATING HOLIDAY
FOR FULL-TIME FIREMEN; AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville,
County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Section 145.05(b) of the Administrative Code be amended to read as follows:

“145.05 HOLIDAYS.

(a) * * * * No Change

(b) *Full-time firemen.* Full-time firemen shall be entitled to seven (7) tours of duty off as holiday credit during the calendar year. The use of more than four (4) hours of compensatory time on a paid holiday shall result in the loss of the holiday pay. **Effective January 1, 2024, full-time firemen shall be entitled to one (1) tour of duty designated as a floating holiday.** All such leave must be taken prior to the end of the calendar year, and such leave shall not be cumulative nor shall compensation be paid in lieu thereof.

(c) through (e) * * * * No Change.”

SECTION 2. Section 145.05(b) of the Administrative Code as it existed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance and all other ordinances or resolutions inconsistent herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is to designate one tour of duty as a floating holiday for full-time firemen, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
