AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE CLEVELAND RESTORATION SOCIETY (CRS) TO PROVIDE ELIGIBLE BRECKSVILLE HOMEOWNERS WITH THE ABILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HERITAGE HOME PROGRAMSM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, CRS has established a program referred to as the Heritage Home ProgramSM for the purpose of enhancing older properties in the participating communities; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined and is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Cleveland Restoration Society for the purpose of providing professional technical assistance to the owners of houses that are over 50 years old in the City in connection with the City's participation in the Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with the Cleveland Restoration Society to provide eligible Brecksville homeowners with the ability to participate in the Heritage Home ProgramSM, a copy of said Agreement being attached hereto and expressly made a part hereof by reference, and marked Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is that it is necessary to provide eligible homeowners with the ability to participate in the Heritage Home ProgramSM, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
