

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
PURCHASE OF THREE (3) 2023 FORD POLICE
UTILITY VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT FROM MONTROSE FORD IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF
OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 125.04(C); AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 125.04(C) of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Brecksville has determined that it is cost effective to purchase vehicles for use by the Police Department from Montrose Ford based upon equivalent State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services – State Purchasing Contract terms, conditions, and specifications, but at a lower price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with Montrose Ford for the purchase of vehicles for the Police Department, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law, based upon the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04(C), as follows:

Three (3) Ford Police Utility Vehicles	\$126,434.88

SECTION 2. Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 3. Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is that the same relates to the daily operation of a municipal department, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
