## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) CONCORD MINUTEMAN SNOW AND ICE CONTROL EQUIPMENT PACKAGE INSTALLED ON NEW CLASS 8 SINGLE AXLE CAB AND CHASSIS FROM CONCORD ROAD EQUIPMENT, MFG. FOR USE BY THE BRECKSVILLE SERVICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**SECTION 2.** The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

**SECTION 3.** The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is it is necessary for the Service Department's daily operations, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
