

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AMMUNITION FOR USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM VANCE’S LAW ENFORCEMENT AND KIESLER POLICE SUPPLY THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES PURCHASING PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions contained in Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City of Brecksville deems it cost effective to purchase certain equipment through the State of Ohio, Administrative Services Purchasing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Brecksville with the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services - State Purchasing, through its authorized vendors, Vance’s Law Enforcement and Kiesler Police Supply, and specifically State Contract #RS900319, for the purchase of the following ammunition for use by the Police Department:

SECTION 3. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 4. The Council declares this Ordinance to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the Police Department's need for ammunition, therefore, said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
