Ordinance No. 5779

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
EXECUTE A GENERAL AGREEMENT REGARDING
LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE
UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR
NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AND THE BRECKSVILLE
POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga Valley National Park is under concurrent jurisdiction, and the National Park Service and the Brecksville Police Department therefore share a common interest in law enforcement in and around the Cuyahoga Valley National Park.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized to execute a General Agreement Regarding Law Enforcement Assistance between The United States Department of the Interior National Park Service and the Brecksville Police Department, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and expressly made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 2. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer’s certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency relates to law enforcement in and around the Cuyahoga Valley National Park, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
