

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR
FUNDING THROUGH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS 2025 COUNTY ROAD
PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE REIMBURSEMENT
PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is soliciting for projects to be considered as part of the 2025 County Road Preventative Maintenance Program for funding; and

WHEREAS, the funding program will reimburse the material costs used for routine maintenance performed on county roads during the 2025 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and hereby is authorized to complete the application process for funding through the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works 2025 County Road Preventative Maintenance Program. The Mayor is further authorized to execute whatever documents are necessary to complete the application process. If successful in obtaining funding, the Mayor is authorized to execute whatever documents are necessary to effectuate the receipt of funds.

SECTION 2. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof, and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof, and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes as expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need to meet the application deadline of Friday, October 25, 2024, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
