

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RENEWAL APPLICATION
FOR PLACEMENT OF FARMLAND IN AN AGRICULTURAL
DISTRICT MADE BY STACEY GIERE FOR PERMANENT
PARCEL NUMBER 604-16-003 LOCATED AT 6530 MILLER
ROAD IN THE CITY OF BRECKSVILLE; AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 929.02 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council hereby approves the renewal application of Stacey Giere for placement of Permanent Parcel Number 604-16-003 located at 6530 Miller Road consisting of approximately 2.668 acres in an agricultural district with the following modification:

1. This approval shall be effective for a five (5) year period from the date the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer approves said application, provided said land maintains its use exclusively as farmland. The Brecksville City Council reserves the right to reevaluate its position concerning the characterization of said land upon reapplication, if any, by the then owner of same.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to indicate this Council's approval of the renewal application of the said Stacey Giere with the above stated modification and transmit said renewal application along with a certified copy of this Resolution to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer. Additionally, the Clerk of Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to transmit by certified mail return receipt requested a copy of this Resolution to Stacey Giere at 6530 Miller Road, Brecksville, Ohio 44141 within five (5) days of the approval of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is the need for Council to take legislative action within a specified statutory time period, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
