

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR AN
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION
OF EMS 2025-2026 EMS GRANT; AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the purpose of the EMS Grant Program is to improve and enhance EMS and trauma patient care in Ohio through the provision of grant funding for equipment, training, and research with funding from fines levied in the State of Ohio for seat belt violations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brecksville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor, be, and hereby is, authorized to complete the application process for an Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS 2025-2026 Ohio EMS Grant and to execute whatever documents are necessary to complete the application process. If successful in obtaining funding, the Mayor is authorized to execute whatever documents are necessary to effectuate the receipt of funds.

SECTION 2. The Council hereby appropriates sufficient funds to effectuate the provisions contained in Section 1 hereof and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to transfer the funds necessary to complete this expenditure from the available funds of the City. The Director of Finance be and is hereby further authorized to issue the fiscal officer's certificate necessary to make the expenditures as described in Section 1 hereof and is further directed to issue vouchers of this City in the amounts and for the purposes expressed in Section 1 hereof, said amounts to be charged to the appropriately designated Fund.

SECTION 3. The Council declares this Resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, the reason for the emergency is that it relates to the need to meet the April 1, 2025 deadline for the application, therefore, said Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by this Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
